Non-Vulnerability Statement regarding Amnesia:33

Dear Sirs and Madams,

The Forescout Research Labs have discovered a series of zero-day vulnerabilities impacting millions of IoT, OT and IT devices. These vulnerabilities present an immediate risk for organizations worldwide.

After carefully analysing the situation we herewith state that no medical product developed by Olympus has been found vulnerably to any of the known Amnesia:33 vulnerabilities. We will update the statement as new information related to Amnesia:33 vulnerability become available.

Background Information

Olympus is aware of and currently monitoring ongoing developments related to the recent public reports of various vulnerabilities that affect the TCP/IP stack, collectively known as Amnesia:33. Successful exploitation of these vulnerabilities may cause memory corruption, allowing attackers to compromise devices, execute malicious code, perform denial-of-service attacks and steal sensitive information.
